

Saturday, September 25th is set for the Current Creek ride. This area is north of Strawberry Res. and chosen in hopes of catching the fall colors. We will be riding 48 miles through Aspen and mixed Conifers gaining an elevation near 10,000'. Moving time is 4 hours. The rating for this ride is moderate with some stretches being easy. Trail is suitable for both SxS and ATV's.

From the mouth of Weber Canyon (Hwy 89 and I-84)to staging area is 94 miles. My driving time was 1 Hr. 40 min. not exceeding 65 mph. You will be driving to Heber City then east on Hwy 40. As you near 94 miles watch for the Co-op, Chicken Creek sign, it will be on the right side. About 500' turn left. If you have made it this far you won't miss the staging area. If you have a GPS use these cords for the staging area: N40 14.646 W111 09.417

Please plan to ride out of the staging area at 0900.

Note: For your convenience there is a 1 hole vault toilet at the staging area. Arrive early to avoid long line.
